**Location:** La Jolla, CA

**Building Size:** (2) 24'x60' & (2) 28'x72'

**Square Feet:** 6,912

**Building Use:** Classrooms, restrooms, supply room, health services office, college counseling office

**Client Challenges:** La Jolla Country Day is a K-12 private school located in prestigious La Jolla Ca. This very popular school had plans to expand the campus but needed interim space until construction commences in a few years. They had two primary challenges; 1) The “temporary” classrooms and offices must be architecturally appealing and conform with surrounding structures 2) The interior floor plan must accommodate multiple classrooms and faculty needs.

**The MBC Solution:** To meet architectural concerns, two of the classrooms had full length color coordinated awnings installed over the entry ways. These not only served as architectural elements but also protected students against inclement weather. The remaining classrooms had asphalt shingled pitched roofs and painted wood siding to compliment the adjoining structures.

Proper space planning for students and faculty members was achieved by building two non standard modular structures. After consulting with school administrators it was determined the industry standard size of 24'x 60' was too small. Therefore, MBC engineered (2) 28'x72' custom buildings that provided four classrooms, each with its own restroom, three supply rooms and an office for health services. All units were delivered in advance of the new school year and were in use for over 3 years. Construction of their new campus is now complete and modular classrooms played a vital role in planning for the new school.
